## LAUNCH OF COUNCIL AMALGAMATIONS: A SEA OF RED INK - 7 March 2019

Save Our Councils Coalition (SOCC) today launched a report called 'A Sea of Red Ink' showing that the Government's forced council amalgamations are a financial failure.

For Northern Beaches Council, the forced merger proposal posited a surplus of \$16.1m for 2018-2019 but its operational plan for the year shows \$8.7m - a shortfall of \$7.4m.

That compares to a combined surplus for Pittwater, Warringah and Manly Councils in 2014 of \$14.2 million - and for 2018-2019 that would have been \$8.8m.


